In order to improve access to safe drinking water and



safer sanitation, a women advocacy group, Women Farmers Advancement Network (WOFAN) has, in collaboration with the United States

Agency for International Development (USAID), to assist 48 benefiting communities of Bauchi State to build, operate and maintain handpump boreholes, ventilated Improved Pit (VIP) toilet blocks, urinal blocks, hand washing stations and rain water catchment systems in their communities and schools. In addition, the group is to work

In addition to handpump installation, maintenance and repairs, the project also focuses on construction of 132 units VIP latrines, urinals and handwashing facilities, says the ED of WOFAN. Community coalitions and environmental health clubs have also been formed and functional to serve the project cycle period
